Dear Resident

We are writing to you regarding recent reports of anti-social behaviour (ASB) and crime in and around Kingsdown Road, St Margaret's.

Kent Police, Dover District Council, and other statutory partners—including mental health services—work closely together to prevent crime and ASB across the district.

We have received reports of ASB, harassment, public order offences, criminal damage, and other related issues. These behaviours cause significant distress and undermine residents' sense of safety and security within the community.

It is important that all incidents are reported individually, rather than relying on one person to report on behalf of others. Individual reports provide vital corroboration and demonstrate the scale of the issue, which in turn supports evidence gathering.

We encourage residents to continue reporting incidents of ASB and crime in the area. If we can investigate further, we'll take some initial steps. These could include:

Talking to witnesses
Assessing the crime scene
Checking CCTV or video footage
Gathering other evidence such as forensic samples

How to Contact Kent Police

• **In an emergency, always dial 999** – this includes where someone is using violence or threatening to be violent.

A serious crime is happening right now.
Someone is in immediate danger or harm.
Property is in danger of being damaged.
