We envisage the stalls running between midday and 4 - 5pm (or longer if you wish) The celebrations run continuously through to 10pm. It is important that the stalls are removed safely and with as little disruption as possible to the exciting action on the stage.

Location:

St Margarets Cricket Field (King George Vth Field),
Glebe Close, St Margaret's at Cliffe, Dover CT15 6AF

Parking:

Townsend Farm Road, St. Margarets-at-Cliffe, Dover, CT15 6JJ

The Townsend Farm Road Car Park will be clearly signposted. It is at the bottom of the Townsend Farm road. This is the public car park for the event. It is adjacent to the King George Vth Field, and as you can see in the site plan below there is a convenient pedestrian access between the two.

The King George Vth Car Park (Cricket Club Car Park) has very limited parking, which is reserved for essential vehicles, and emergency services. The drive leading upto the cricket club (Glebe Close) will be closed to ensure it does not get blocked and there is always access for emergency vehicle access. There will be a marshal at the end of the road from 10am.

Due to the nature of the event, we are limiting any car movements during the day. We recommend that stall orders use the public Townsend park road car park at the beginning and the end of the day. By arriving early you should be able to park your vehicle near to the pedestrian gate and it is not far to where the stalls are to be laid out. You may wish to bring a trolley or other device to move your items. We have police cadet marshals on site who may be able to help.

We can, on request, allow vehicle access to King George Vth field to set up but all vehicles would have to be removed by 11.30am. Vehicles will not be allowed back on site until after 10pm so it is probably easier to get a good spot in the public car park first thing. There are some limited exceptions to this rule e.g. Bouncy castle van.

Tables, Stall Locations, Gazebos and Power


We will have a limited number of tables that groups are able to use for the jubilee, so please bring your own if you can.

Unfortunately, we are only able to provide power to the essential functions, stage and catering facilities.

Most stalls will be located around the cricket square, which will be cordoned off to keep this lawn protected. Some stalls with special requirements will be located elsewhere. We will be attempting to group the stalls into similar categories. Details of your spot will follow.

You are more than welcome to bring your own gazebo or covering, and you will probably want to bring chairs. Please try and bring ones that will not damage the cricket field.
